

Pavilion of Al-Andalus and Science

Granada, Spain



The Pavilion of al-Andalus and Science forms part of the fourth phase of the expansion of the Park of the Sciences of Granada, with a novel educational and informative installation which demonstrates decisive a bid for the diffusion of the Heritage and relations with the Arab world.

The Pavilion goes beyond a simple museum. It is a space for scientific learning and awareness. The museography proposed by ACCIONA Producciones y Diseño materializes in a permanent exhibition that illustrates the principal references of the Andalusí scientific-technological heritage.

The exhibition contents are formed on the basis of a vanguard design that is completely accessible, a fundamental key for strengthening informative presentations. The thematic rooms that talk about astronomy and mathematics, geography, navigation, medicine, zoology, agronomy and botany, architecture, ceramics, glass or textiles, are distributed in a labyrinthine and colorful space, thanks to the enormous tapestry graphics that demarcate the rooms. An effect is achieved that recalls the very "being" of the Andalusian street markets, where the atmosphere and light have a magical color and taste.

In these "spheres of knowledge", visitors complete what they know by means of mechanical and digital interactives that put into practice ingenuity and intuition.
