The exhibition proposal for the Museum of the Autonomous Region of Andalusia has a clear artistic vocation that, without losing rhythm and rigor, harmoniously shows historical and present-day contents.

Modernity, avant-garde and innovation are three inseparable elements throughout the highly visual itinerary of the history of the autonomous region, present-day Andalusia, its institutions, its symbols and its people.

Almost all of the space is a large artistic scenography in white that, respecting the architecture and integrating itself into it, symbolizes the process of Andalusia's autonomy, from its beginnings until the present, a present narrated by the Andalusians themselves in a spectacular audiovisual production.

The rest of the space is converted into an intimate place where the visitor can learn about the Andalusians themselves, the institutions that represent them and the symbols that have become their signs of identity.
