Across. The Cyclades and Western Anatolia during the 3rd Millenium BC

Sakıp Sabancı Museum. Istanbul, Turkey



"Across, The Cyclades and Western Anatolia during the 3rd Millennium BC" is a temporary exhibition located in the Sakıp Sabancı Museum of Istanbul that represents the commercial and cultural relationship between Anatolia and the Cycladic Islands across the Aegean Sea.

The space created for this exhibition, composed of more than 300 objects from different Greek and Turkish museums, presents the cultural similarities of both regions.

The perimeter of the room shows extraordinary large scale drawings that illustrate social and economic aspects of life on both sides of the Aegean and testify to the similarities of both cultures, contextualizing in an educational manner the objects on display.

The use of exquisite lighting creates an intimate and theatrical ambience. The visit ends with a 14-meter long replica of a boat characteristic of the 3rd Millennium, the most relevant means of transportation between the two shores of the Aegean Sea.
